Kevin is currently a member of The PGA of America's Member Tournament Committee. He has chaired several of the Section's Committees over the past 13 years. Kevin also served two consecutive 2-year terms on the USGA Green Section Committee, possibly the only PGA Professional to ever serve on that committee. Kevin is also a member of the Titleist Leadership Advisory Staff and the Imperial Headwear Regional Advisory Board. In addition to The PGA of America, He is a member of the Club Manager's Association of America.

Kevin was selected as the MAPGA's Assistant PGA Professional of the Year in 1998, the Horton Smith Award winner in 2001, the Merchandiser of the Year (Private Category) in 2002 and the MAPGA PGA Professional of the Year in 2006. He attributes his success to hard work, a positive attitude, and involvement in Chapter and Section affairs. Kevin believes in the importance of meeting people, networking, and developing lasting relationships. He feels very fortunate to have worked with and around many accomplished PGA Professionals. Kevin takes great pride in being a PGA Professional.
