Each scholarship will be worth \$2500 each. Hurley believes in the importance of furthering one's education and hopes that this scholarship helps a student achieve their educational goals.

Other factors to be considered may include, but are not limited to: extracurricular activities, financial need, content of required essays, Military background, references and off-course behavior.
