

2019 Global Golf Sales MAPGA Commitment Cup

In 2019, the MAPGA has teamed with Global Golf Sales to introduce the inaugural Global Golf Sales MAPGA Commitment Cup. The tournament will be held on October 21, 2019 (the first day of the Players' Cup) at Woodmont Country Club. This event is designed for ALL members and associates to have a chance to compete and win on a level playing field. Throughout the year, MAPGA professionals and associates will earn Section-oriented "commitment" points (listed below) by participating in events to play in the Commitment Cup, and the top 50 points-earners will be invited to compete for the Cup.

The format of the event will be based on a points quota. The goal is to beat your target points, and the golfer who exceeds that goal by the most is the winner. Your target score will be based on your scoring average throughout the year. For example, for a golfer that his/her scoring average is 72, their quota will be 36 points whereas for a golfer whose scoring average is 79, their quota will be 29. Target points will be sent out after the Northern Chapter Fall Meeting & Pro-Pro on October 14. If you happen to earn enough commitment points but do not play in any MAPGA golf events, the Cup Committee will give you a quota based on past performances throughout the last couple of years.

The purse for this year's Commitment Cup will be \$4,700 and paid out to 10% of the field. Thus, if we have 50 golfers, 1st place will be ~\$1,500.

Cost – If you play in the Players' Cup and are also eligible to play in the Commitment Cup, there will be no additional entry fee. If you do NOT play in the Players' Cup, the fee will be \$60 to play in the Commitment Cup.

Earning Commitment Points*

* Points will be back dated from January 1, 2019

- 5 points for attending the Spring Section Membership Meeting
- 5 points for attending each Chapter Membership Meeting (up to 10 points maximum)
- 5 points for attending Section-run Educational Seminar (up to 10 points maximum)
- 5 points for participating in the following Tournaments:
 - o Match Play Championship
 - o Chapter Championship
 - o Pro- Net Championship
 - o Stroke Play Championship
 - o Professional Championship
- Additional 5 points for finishing in the Top 10 in the Open Division and Top 5 in the Senior Division of any of the events listed above. For the Match Play, the Top 8 will receive an additional 5 points.
