For the past two years I have been a Veterans Administration Vendor, providing Three, Five session, two-hour clinics every season. The attendees are patients of the Perry Point Veterans Hospital and either live on the grounds and are driven to the clinics or are patients of the Hospital but can drive. We have seen an increase in Junior Golf at Holly Hills, almost doubling our PGA Junior League team and camp participation size from the year prior. A lot of the juniors are

beginners and don't have clubs. We have donated clubs now, but most are very old. We request the grant money to purchase new US Kids golf sets for players who may not have the proper equipment. New junior sets come sized correctly by height, weight, and swing speed. When kids use equipment that fits them, it helps promote correct posture, grip, and swing mechanics right from the start. Also, reducing bad habits that form when clubs are too heavy or too long. Kids feel more confident when they have equipment that looks, feels, and performs like It's made for them. New clubs create excitement, boost pride, and help juniors enjoy the game

more, which increases retention and long-term participation. Although it's an upfront investment, new clubs hold their quality longer, can often be handed down, and reduce the need for repairs or replacements due to equipment failure. By investing in our junior players, we are building the foundation for the next generation of golfers and ultimately growing the game we all love.
